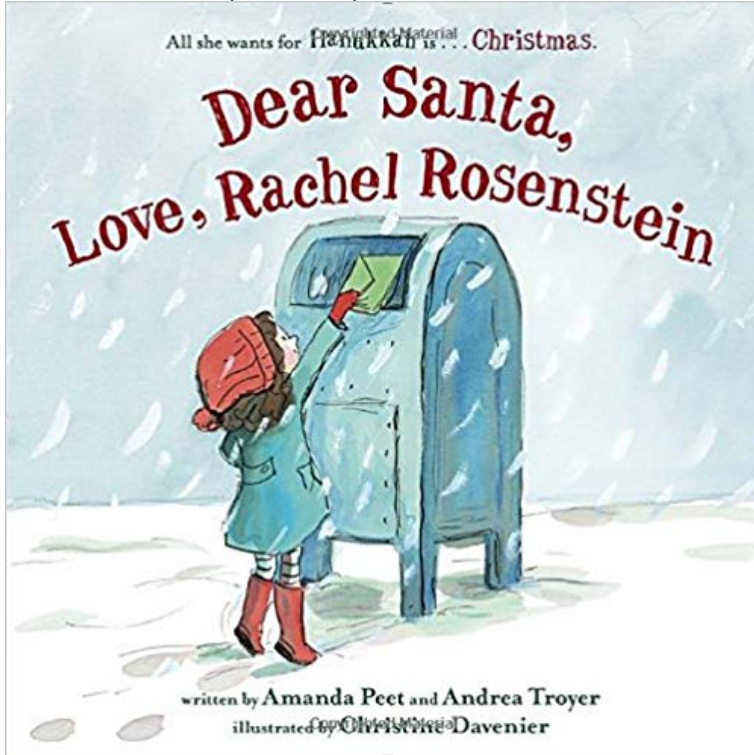


Dear Santa, Love, Rachel Rosenstein
