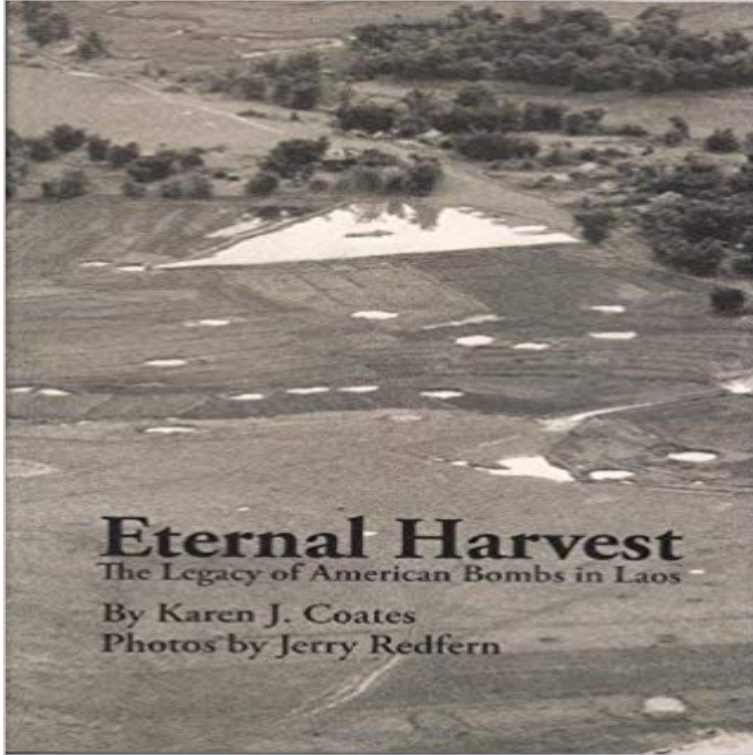


Eternal Harvest: The Legacy of American Bombs in Laos
