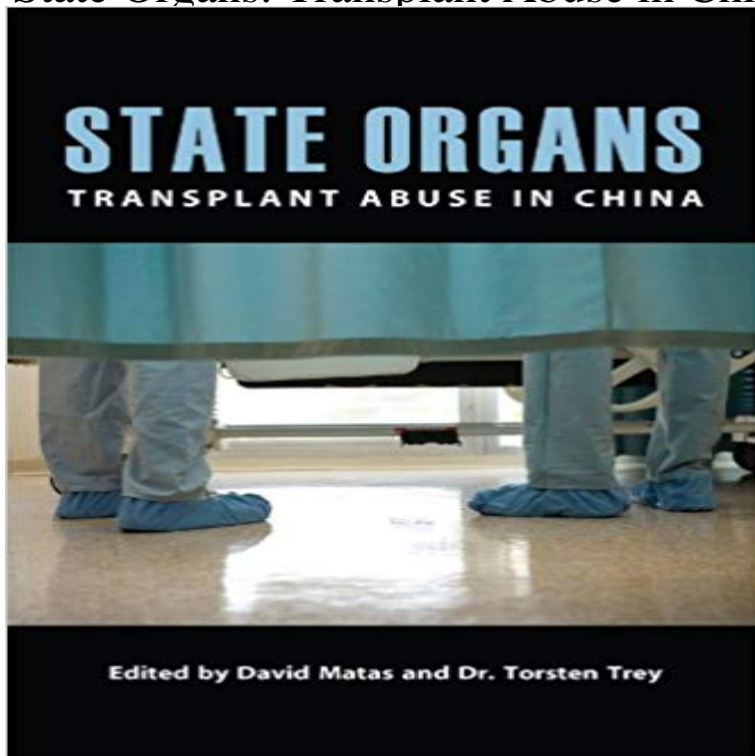


State Organs: Transplant Abuse in China
