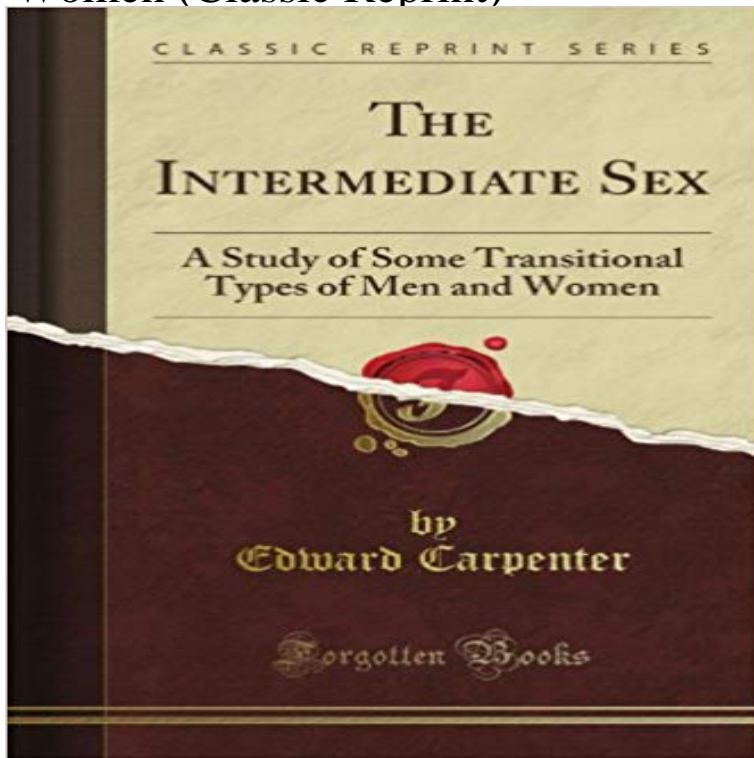


The Intermediate Sex: A Study of Some Transitional Types of Men and Women (Classic Reprint)
